The membership approved funds to purchase a laptop computer to replace the card box which will be located close to where the card box is now. The laptop will be anchored in such a way as to avoid mysterious disappearance. This advance will allow the membership committee to better track work hours as well as the individual member.

- Sweep all floors. Inspect showers and clean if necessary (Basement showers as well).
- Mop all floors.
- Clean bathrooms (sinks, stools, etc.)
- Clean bar area.
- Stock all coolers.
- Replace all floor mats.
- Restock bathrooms (deodorizer, paper towels, toilet paper, etc.)
- Place chairs on floor.
- Clean dirty dishes in kitchen (within reason), then put away.
