Trailers

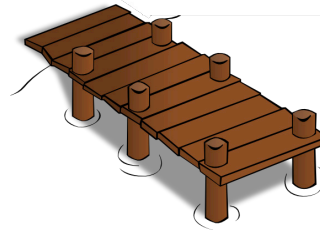
To keep our Club looking ship-shape, we ask members who have trailers at the Club to please make sure to keep the areas properly mowed.
