Congrats to the **Anchor Softball** team who finished 2nd in the mid-season tournament!

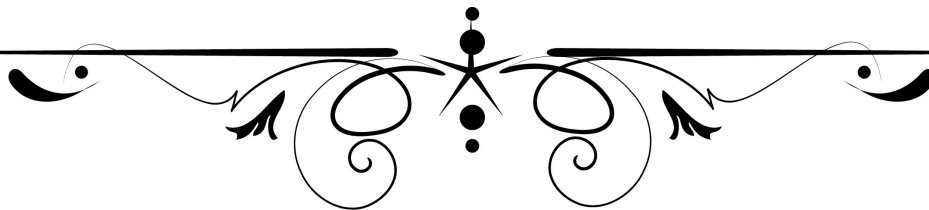
Building of the multi-purpose building awaits city approval.

The July Membership meeting originally scheduled for July 3rd has been moved to **July 10th** .

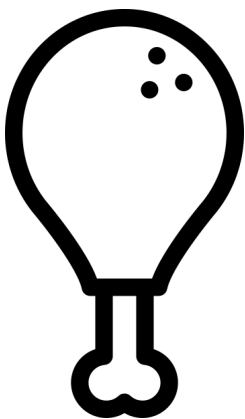
