

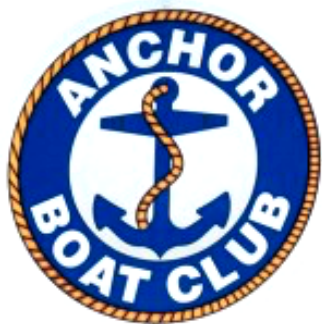

Nice job **Tim** and **SJ** for trimming branching on the grounds.

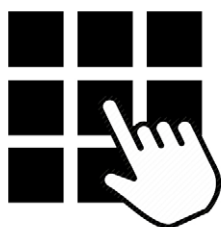
The new building is nearing completion and looks great. Cannot wait until **Jimmy** paints it...

As of April 30th we have a total of 183 Active members, 8 of these are Probationary, and 53 of these are Honorary. Sadly 3 of our members left this earth during the 2018-2019 year, **Gene Edwards** (honorary) joined in 1977, **Bernie Owens** (honorary) joined in 1988, and **Peter J. Sidener** joined in 2017. Unfortunately we had 7 members drop this year, which on the bright side is the lowest number of drop in the past 6 years.

There was a total of 3,535 hours recorded for 2018-2019, of these 1,825 or 52%. Remember 8 of the 16 hours required are to be done during our major events, Spooner, Chicken Fry, Fall Festival, and Fish Frys. Remember **16 hours is the minimum**, not the maximum. 16 hours \* 130 non-honorary members = 2,080 total hours. Some examples of

how you can get more hours recorded would be to help out with the grounds by picking up sticks, raking leaves, mowing the lawn, etc... check with **TJ Martin** for other grounds related work. Check with **SJ Martin** to help with the campground maintenance, **Mike Broglin** to help with building maintenance, or **Mike Hessler** to help with bar tasks. Thursday night is always a great night to restock the bar, and there is always a need for an inside bartender during the bocce season.
