For those of you that have never participated, let me give you a simple version of how the drawing works. Raffle tickets are sold for **\$1 each** or **6 for \$5.00**. You can buy as many as you like. Ticket sales start around 6:00pm and ends at 8:00.

At 8:00pm, one ticket is drawn at random and the person with the winning ticket gets to select one card from the board. If the card inside the envelope is the Queen of Hearts, that person wins the pot. If it is any other card, the card is tacked onto the board and the game goes on for another drawing on the next game night. The pot is increased each time by a percent of the night's sales.
