Life Saving Opportunity

Fellow Anchor members, we have an opportunity through the American Red Cross to provide Adult and Pediatric CPR and AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) classes.



The cost per person is \$75.00. The class will

be open to club members and their families. There is a minimum class size of 25 participants.

With the wide age group of our members and close proximity to water, there is a need for each of us to look out for our fellow members so what a great idea it would be to have several members trained in CPR and AED use.

The club is considering the purchase of an AED device and have it located in the commons area of the club. There is no better gift you can give another than having the knowledge to help save a life when needed.

The American Red Cross will come to the club and perform the training. As soon as we have a full class, we will set it up on an available weekend. The certification will last for two years.
