## By-laws Change Proposal

21 FEBRUARY 2023 ANCHOR BOAT CLUB 407 E. LAKE SHORE DRIVE LAKE SPRINGFIELD SPRINGFIELD, ILLINOIS 62712

PROPOSAL FOR EDITS AND ADMINISTRATIVE ADDITIONS TO ANCHOR BOAT CLUB BY-LAWS

In accordance with Article X (Amendment of Bylaws) of the current Anchor Boat Club bylaws, the following edits and additions are proposed as changes to existing bylaws.

EDIT 1: Article V - Election of Officers. Section 4.

Change hours of voting from 1:00PM-7:00PM to 5:00PM-7:00PM

Will read, "The election for the office of President, Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, Sergeant-at-Arms and the expiring member's term on the Board of Governors, shall be held at the Club house on the first meeting in March of each current year between the hours of five (5:00) p.m. and seven (7:00) p.m.

### EDIT 2: Section 7, para a.

• Remove the word "ownership" and replace with "lease". Will read, "To supervise the change or acquisition of lease of the docks, whether by sale, lease, gift or other transfer as well as the construction of/or addition to any dock; no such sale, lease, gift or other transfer of/or construction or addition to any dock shall be made without the permission of the Dock Committee being first had and obtained in writing.

### EDIT 3: Section 7, para c.

- Remove the word "own" and replace with "lease" and remove the word "purchase" with "lease"
- Will read, "That the Chairperson of the Dock Committee or some member thereof selected by said Chairperson, shall at all times keep and post a current list of members who: (1) lease a dock, (2) desire to sell a dock, (3) desire and are eligible to lease a dock.

EDIT 4: Section 7 para d.

- Remove the word "owners" and replace with "lease holder"
- Will read: To see that good and proper maintenance of docks is kept at all times by the lease holders thereof; to see that all construction, additions and repairs of docks are made in a good workmanlike manner, the permission and approval of the Dock Committee being first obtained in writing.

#### ADDITION 1 - ADDED ARTICLE XI

 Article XI to be added for non-profit IRS and insurance purposes.

# ARTICLE XI - DISSOLUSION OF ANCHOR BOAT CLUB ORGANIZATION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
