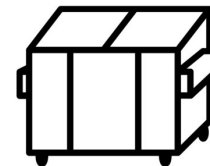

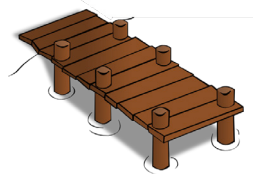
## Keep It Clean
